- (1) Virtue: Ability to make a team

Learning: We won't grow if there's infighting and we don't work as a team. / If there is no harmony, a team can't grow.

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(2) Virtue: Faith

Learning: One needs to believe in something beyond yourself – it can even be a higher cause.

(3) Virtue: Capacity to communicate

Learning: When working in a team, just what you think and experience is not important - one should be able to express himself clearly and convince others as well.

(4) Virtue: Methodology

Learning: One should have a clear way to achieve your goal. / Not somehow, but show how you will achieve it.

(5) Virtue: Ability to make a team

Learning: One should trust and empower others.

2) Ananyata / Arpanta / undivided devotion/surrendership - 1/2 mark
6. When Param Krupalu Dev was before Pujyashri Ambalalbai, he used to see Param Krupalu Dev beyond him. / Pujyashri Ambalalbai used to see Him not as a person who used to talk on Dharma, but as an embodiment of Dharma.
